HOSPITALITY AND HOTEL ADMINISTRATION-1

ESSENTIAL

First class 3 year Degree/Diploma (after 10 +2) in HMCT or equivalent **OR** First class 4 year Bachelor's Degree in HMCT or equivalent.

AND

Good academic record with at least 55% of the marks (50% in case of SC/ST/ Physically & Visually handicapped candidates) or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D,E & F at the Master's degree in HMCT **or** any other areas like Food processing, Food & Nutrition, Tourism Management, Tourism Administration etc. from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.

Due weightage will be given for Industry/Professional experience.

NET/SLET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of lecturers in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the "University Grants Commission (minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulation 2009, shall be exempt from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions."

NET/SLET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of lecturers in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the "University Grants Commission (minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulation 2009, shall be exempt from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions."

Good academic record with at least 55% of the marks (50% in case of SC/ST/Physically & Visually handicapped candidates) or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level, in the relevant subject i.e. **Police Administration/Public Administration** from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.

Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates with postgraduate degree should have cleared the Eligibility Test (NET) for Lecturers conducted by the UGC. However, the candidates having Ph.D. degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET for PG level and UG level teaching. The candidates having M.Phil degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET for UG level teaching only. This would be effective from 14.06.2006 i.e. the date of issue of letter by the UGC vide D.O. No. F.1-1/2002(PS) Exemp.

DESIRABLE

Teaching experience preferably in the course of Police Administration.

- (i) At least 55% marks (50% in case of SC/ST/ Physically & Visually handicapped candidates) or an equivalent grade at Master's degree level;

However, the candidates having Ph.D. degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET for PG level and UG level teaching. The candidates having M.Phil degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET for UG level teaching only. This would be effective from 14.06.2006 i.e. the date of issue of letter by the UGC vide D.O. No. F.1-1/2002(PS) Exemp.

NET/SLET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of lecturers in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the "University Grants Commission (minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulation 2009, shall be exempt from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions."

NET/SLET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of lecturers in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the "University Grants Commission (minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulation 2009, shall be exempt from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions."
