MECHANICAL ENGINEERING-2

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

- i. First Class degree both in B.E./ B.Tech. and M.E./ M.Tech. in Mechanical Engineering. The candidates holding dual/integrated B.E./B.Tech. and M.E./M.Tech. degree or single integrated M.E./M.Tech. degree will also be eligible.
- ii. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
 1. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
 2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or in refereed journals.

COMPUTER SCIENCE & ENGG.-2

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

- i) First Class in B.E./ B.Tech. in Computer Science & Engineering and M.E./ M.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering/ Software Engineering/ Information Technology. - III. Notwithstanding anything contained in clauses (i) and (ii) above the candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility

condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

The Candidate must also possess Sufficient knowledge of Disaster Management.

- II. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- III. Notwithstanding anything contained in clauses (i) and (ii) above the candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Degree in the Mentally Retarded area with not less than 55% of marks or an equivalent grade of B in 7 point scale or an equivalent degree from a foreign University recognized by RCI.

Ph.D./M.Phil in Education with research emphasis on Special Education.

Experience for a period of at least 3 years as teacher or as researcher in the area of Learning Disability or 3 years of teaching experience at the Diploma level.

VIII. For the post of Assistant Professor in Tourism Management at University Institute of Hotel Management -1

Thorough training in the field of Animal Tissue Culture/Stem Cell Biology/Development Biology/Reproductive Biology is the mandatory requirement.

A minimum of two years of experience of teaching and also research excluding the period spent for obtaining the Ph.D. degree in the subjects mentioned above is necessary. The candidates are required to teach newly introduced two-years course in Stem Cell and Tissue Engineering at M.Sc. level and conduct research in the area.

- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in clauses (i) and (ii), candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulations 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.”
- iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

DESIRABLE

Preference will be given to the candidates possessing Doctoral Degree or equivalent degree with peer reviewed published work in the fields related to Stem Cell Biology/Tissue Engineering.
